



2021 - 2022 Education Grant Program

The Randolph County Recycling District is pleased to offer an educational grant program! Education grants are offered to all third and fourth grade classrooms for project supplies, books, activities, field trips or other endeavors which teach students about the 3 R's (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle), vermicomposting, or how to be good stewards of our natural resources.

Eligibility:

All 3rd and 4th grade educators within Randolph County are eligible to apply. Grant funds will be paid to the school or school district. A grant agreement promising to use the funds only for the experience or project submitted must be signed, and a final grant report must be submitted at the close of the experience or project.

Project Guidelines:

Applicants may apply for a grant of any value up to \$1,000 for the 2021 - 2022 school year. The funds must be distributed during the 2021 - 2022 school year. Proposals may include but are not limited to: new or expanding recycling programs within the school, project supplies, books, activities, field trips or other endeavors which teach students about the 3 R's (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle), vermicomposting, or how to be good stewards of our natural resources.

Grant Review Process:

Each grant application will be reviewed by the District's Citizen's Advisory Committee ("CAC"), and the District staff. The CAC, with input from the staff, will forward the applications and their recommendations to the District's Board members. The Board will review the applications and the recommendations provided. It will then determine which project(s) are most worthy of funding based on the predetermined selection criteria listed on the application. Decisions of the District's Board members whether to grant funds at any particular time are subject to the sole discretion of the Board, regardless of the merit of any pending applications, and any solicitation by the District of applications under the Grant Program does not bind the District to provide funding to any project(s).

Attendance is not mandatory, but applicants are welcome to attend to answer any potential inquiries from Board members.

Implementation of Selected Grant Projects: Upon selection, all grantees will receive an award letter that will give additional information regarding the awarded grant funds. The award letter will include such information as the monetary value, the steps on how to obtain funds and the requirements of the final report. Grantees are also requested to report to the Board after the funds have been used as to the success of the project in the way of a letter, pictures (appreciated) and/or a visit from the educator or students.
